Our education program has continued to expand with new after-school programs, partnerships with City of Refuge and Gresham Recreation Center, and full-production classes that will perform on our stage.

Our 25th Season started in early July with our board of directors approving our next 5-year strategic plan. The plan charts the next part of our vision to manifest brave space that fosters authentic community through theatre. *Ms. Holmes & Ms. Watson - #2B*, the first show of our season, was called "a spoof that really is a hoot." (ArtsATL) We are also thrilled to announce that we are working with Bweela Steptoe to develop a new musical premiere of John Steptoe's *Mufaro's Beautiful Daughters*, highlighting the talents of LeRell Ross (music) and Taryn Janelle (lyrics). And most recently, our productions garnered 4 Suzi Bass Award nominations, including Best Ensemble for *The Bluest Eye* and Outstanding Production of a Play for *Legacy of Light*.


