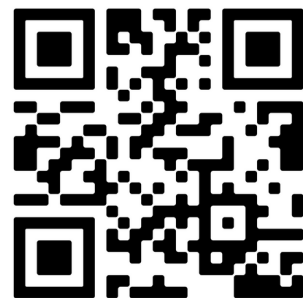

## **About Us**

**Synchronicity Theatre uplifts the voices of women and girls and builds community through theatre.**

Each year we produce five mainstage productions in our Bold Voices and Family Series. We send our New Stages tour around the Southeast. Our Stripped Bare arts incubator project supports the growth of new works by emerging artists. In our education program, Playmaking for Girls uplifts and empowers girls from both group homes and the refugee community, Playmaking for Women supports survivors of sex trafficking, while Playmaking for Kids inspires the imaginations of children ages 4 - 14 at schools across the metro area. Our Production Boot Camp is transforming the technical workforce across the entire theatre community. During each show, we partner with local organizations to engage audiences beyond the stage. We bring issues raised in our shows to panels, exhibits, and workshops. We also spark dialogue through post-show chats.

Eight recent Suzi Bass wins for our shows and Best Theatre - Audience Choice Award; the Community Engagement Award from the American Society for Theatre Research; named one of the 'Eight Top-Notch Children's Theatres in Atlanta' by Atlanta Parent Magazine and one of the '10 Best Live Theatre Venues' by BestThingsGA; received the International Center for Women Playwrights 50/50 Applause Award for five years and counting; we are a member of the new Bloomberg Philanthropies Arts Innovation Management cohort; and one of only two organizations to receive the prestigious 2018 Managing for Excellence Award from the Community Foundation for Greater Atlanta.

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Synchronicity Theatre was awarded the 2021 Governor's Award for the Arts and Humanities honoring our outstanding and significant contributions to Georgia's civic and cultural vitality through excellence and service to the arts and humanities. Presented by the Office of the Governor in partnership with Georgia Council for the Arts and Georgia Humanities, the Governor's Awards recognize the value of the arts and humanities in the creation of a thriving economy and their contributions to education, innovation, growth and quality of life. The Governor's Awards pay tribute to the most distinguished citizens and organizations that have demonstrated a lifetime commitment to work in these fields.
