Please note: *The 2026-27 Stripped Bare season will be held at the Synchronicity Annex, 1586 Piedmont Ave NE, Atlanta, GA 30324. The Annex space has a 40 seat audience capacity and a 30 by 20 stage with basic lighting and sound capabilities. There will be minimal 'backstage' space set up with pipe and drape, with no dressing rooms, so please scale your Stripped Bare proposals accordingly. A great chance to really embrace the Stripped Bare aesthetic!*

- Emerging or Early-career (have at least one paid, professional credit on your resume, but have not originated/created more than five projects in a professional setting) OR artists of any level of experience trying out a new skill-set (have not originated/created more than five projects in a professional setting in this discipline, ie: long-term actors writing for the first time)

Please submit whatever you think best represents your or your team's work.
